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## **ReFocus Achievements Report**

At ReFocus, we are delighted to announce that our students have been performing significantly above the national average for the third consecutive year. Given our nurturing environment, ReFocus is a small provision with a sample size of fewer than 15 students. Therefore, large differences in comparison data can be influenced by the performance of just 1-2 students.

## **Academic Performance**

**English**: This year, 69% of our leavers achieved a pass, marking an improvement from the previous year. This success reflects our dedicated approach to supporting students in their literacy development.

**Maths**: Although there was a slight dip in the pass rate to 50%, it remains well above the national average. Our commitment to providing individualized support has helped maintain strong performance in this core subject.

## **Comparative Analysis**

ReFocus students have outperformed those at similar schools. To draw meaningful comparisons, we have matched our Level 2 Functional Skills results with 9-4 GCSE data. While Functional Skills is a less common examination route for KS4, local colleges recognize Level 2 passes as equivalent to GCSE grades 9-4. This recognition ensures our students have valuable qualifications for their future educational and career paths.



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## **Vocational and Additional Qualifications**

**Construction**: For the second consecutive year, over 75% of our students passed the Construction qualification. As our main focus subject, we are very pleased with these results, which highlight the effectiveness of our practical and hands-on teaching approach.

**Employability and Personal Social Development**: All students entered for these qualifications achieved them, accounting for 75% and 80% of our cohort, respectively. Employability is part of the Construction qualification but can also be a standalone qualification. Our students' dedication to gaining the necessary credits for this additional qualification is commendable.

**Sport Leaders**: In its second year, the Sport Leaders program saw a decline in the pass rate. However, with the introduction of option blocks this year, we are optimistic about achieving better results next year. This program is designed to develop leadership skills and promote physical fitness among our students.

**Mechanics**: This subject continues to be a strong area for ReFocus, with the pass rate matching that of the previous year. Our Mechanics program provides students with valuable technical skills and knowledge, preparing them for careers in the automotive industry.

**Health, Lifestyle, and Science**: This new subject had a great starting pass rate, indicating a promising addition to our curriculum. We are excited to see how this program develops and contributes to our students' overall education.
